



#### Vesicle Composition: The Importance of Diversity




- •Allows for self-assembly

- Nature does the work




Regions of high steric strain







## Inducing Deformations.



A vesicle with a higher sugar concentration in its environment will have water diffusing outward.






Momentum of the laser photons traps particles with higher refractive indices (n).



## Nature at Work: Losing the Elliptical Mode











# Visualizing Higher Modes



- Decay time = 10 s
- Elliptical decay time for the same GUV was 30 s
- 3x more rapid decay for the square mode
